### LOT 1015

A Chinese famille rose export porcelain part tea service, Qianlong period, comprising globular teapot and cover, sparrow beak cream jug and cover, four teabowls and three coffee cups, each painted and gilt with figural scenes and bird vignettes within iron red and black cell diaper borders, height of teapot 13.5cm (all four teabowls with hairline cracks).

### Condition Report

Teapot - in generally good condition, no significant damage or repairs, typical wear to decoration and gilding - more pronounced on handle and knob finial.

Jug - in generally good condition with no chips, cracks or restoration, typical wear to enamels and gilding - more pronounced on handle and knob finial.

Cups - all three in generally good condition, no chips, cracks or restoration, typical wear to enamels and gilding - more pronounced to handles.

Teabowls - all four with hairline crack to rim, 2 with minor rim chips, typical surface scratches and wear to enamels and gilding.
