A Chinese famille rose export porcelain punchbowl, Qianlong period, painted and gilt in the Mandarin palette with figural panels within 'Y' diaper borders, height 12.7cm, diameter 28.5cm (hairline cracks and rivet repaired), together with a Chinese blue and white export porcelain punchbowl, late Qianlong period, painted with famille rose urns and flowers, height 12cm, diameter 27.7cm (hairline crack).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

Famille rose punchbowl - 2 vertical hairline cracks to rim, one 11cm long with rivet repair, the other 10cm long. Thumbnail sized chip to rim and minor chip to footrim, typical light surface scratches and wear to enamels and gilding, but otherwise decoration is good, bright and vibrant.

Blue and white punchbowl - hairline crack to rim running vertically approx 10.5cm long. 3 minor rim chips, typical surface scratches and wear to glaze and enamels.
