A Chinese flambé and crackle glazed porcelain vase, probably early 20th century, of stout ovoid form with three scroll handles, the short cylindrical neck covered in a purple and pale blue drip glaze, above a white crackle glazed body, unmarked, height 17cm.

Condition Report

1036. Generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches to glaze. There appears to be a 1.7cm hairline crack to the rim, but this could have been part of the crackled design that has worsened slightly.
