A collection of Chinese porcelain, 19th century and later, including a Canton cylindrical teapot and cover, decorated with butterflies, height 14.3cm, another Canton famille rose teapot and cover, a pair of blue and white porcelain hu vases, height 9cm, a famille verte ginger jar and cover, painted with a fenghuang, height 15cm, and a blanc-de-Chine figure of Guanyin, height 46cm (some faults).

Estimate: £70 - £100

Condition Report

1068. Canton butterfly teapot - repaired chips to rim of cover. Chip to inner rim of teapot and restoration to rim. Typical wear to enamels and gilt.

Guanyin - chip to finger, otherwise ok.

Ginger jar and cover - small firing crack to rim, wear to enamels and glaze.

Birds and bamboo ginger jar - good condition.

Green glazed jar - chip to footrim, otherwise ok.

Blue bowl - good condition, wear to gilt.

Canton cup - good condition.

Pair of blue and white vases - one with hairline crack and bruise to rim, otherwise ok and other vase in good condition.

Turquoise Buddhistic lion - good condition.

Small Canton teapot - missing cover, hairline crack to bottom of handle and wear to enamels.

Canton cylindrical teapot - restored spout, otherwise ok.
