A small collection of Chinese ceramics and works of art, 18th century and later, including a famille rose export porcelain plate, Qianlong period, painted with flowers, diameter 22.4cm, a famille rose turquoise ground bowl, diameter 15.8cm, and a brass figure of Buddha, height 13.5cm.

Estimate: £50 - £100

Condition Report

1168 - Celadon figure - Good condition.

Two Yixing teapots - Good condition.

Famille rose plate - Good condition, some wear to enamels, no chips, cracks or repairs.

Blue and White octagonal plate - Chips to rim and two cracks.

Turquoise ground bowl - Good condition.

Imari bowl - Hairline crack to rim and numerous rim chips/glaze fritting. Some wear to enamels and gilt.

Canton teabowl - Good condition. Typical light surface scratches and wear.

Canton vase - Slightly reduced neck, otherwise ok. Some wear to gilt and enamels.

Blue and white vase - Good condition.

Brass Buddha - Good condition. Typical light surface scratches and wear.

Metal stand - Ok but scratched.

Soapstone figure - Minor chips, otherwise ok. Base is separate with glue residue visible where once fixed together.
