A collection of Japanese ceramics, Meiji period and later, including three Imari dishes, diameters 40.5cm, 31cm and 30cm, a Kutani wine ewer, height 26.5cm, and a Satsuma part coffee set, decorated with gilt on a black ground.

Condition Report

1167 - Large Imari dish - Broken and re-glued section of rim, otherwise ok.

Kutani teapot - One spout broken and re-glued. Typical light crazing and minor wear, otherwise ok.

Imari vase - Chips to rim.

Satsuma ground vase - Broken in half and re-glued, also wear to gilt.

Satsuma vase - Drilled hole to base, otherwise ok.

Imari dish - Good condition. Typical wear to gilt and enamels.

Imari floral dish - Few minor chips to rim and a small hairline to rim. Minor wear to gilt.

All other pieces in good condition with no chips, cracks or repairs. Only typical light wear.
