A Rockingham porcelain miniature floral encrusted teapot and cover, circa 1830, puce printed mark to base, height 6.5cm, a similar miniature floral encrusted jug and sucrier and cover, a miniature Meissen floral encrusted vase and cover, height 4cm, and a small group of other ceramics, including a Vienna style oblong dish painted with two horses, length 15.5cm, two Shelley miniature cups and saucers, a heart shaped floral painted trinket box, a Goss model of The Melrose Cup and a Continental Meissen style model of a pigeon, unmarked, height 8.8cm.

### Condition Report

Rockingham teapot - fundamentally in good condition overall with very indistinct small vertical hairline to rim, some possible regilding to edge of cover and typical minor chips to applied flowers and foliage, none too terrible.

Miniature jug - in good condition overall, fine crazing to glaze, minuscule enamel nick to green handle.

Sucrier - minuscule nicks to petals, otherwise good.

Bird - small area of restoration to side of beak.

Miniature Meissen - probably a matched cover, small regilded nick to neck rim edge, tiny nicks to relief detail.

Remaining items in the lot are in good condition overall with no damage or repairs.
