LOT 1880

A pair of French turquoise glass opaline vases and covers, late 19th/early 20th century, of baluster shape enamelled in an aesthetic manner with insects and butterflies on and around spring flowers, the edges with gilt line and white dotted borders, painted numerals to bases, height 17cm, together with a similar opaline glass vase with geometric enamelled detail, height 32cm, and two soda glass paperweights with internal bubble decoration (some faults).

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

The pair of vases and covers are in good condition overall with no damage or repairs - the decoration is good with very minor wear.

The two paperweights are in good condition with minor typical surface scratches.

The vase with geometric decoration has a filled plaster base, suggesting it is probably more likely to be a shade - it has some minor nicks to the base edge and would appear to have originally had gilt decoration which has now completely worn, the remaining decoration also has areas of wear. There are surface scratches.
