LOT 1558

A matched group of Dresden porcelain tablewares, 20th century, of wrythen moulded form typically painted with floral bouquets and scattered sprigs beneath gilt rims, comprising eight plates 22cm diameter, two saucer plates 12.5cm diameter, nine coffee cups and saucers, four leaf shaped dishes 24cm long and four leaf shaped dishes 16cm long, together with a small pair of Dresden yellow ground vases and covers painted with figural and foliate panels within gilt borders, height 10cm, and two similarly painted Dresden chocolate cups, covers and saucers, one with yellow ground, the other turquoise, each with tripod claw feet and entwined serpent handles.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

The Dresden tablewares each have a similar mark - blue painted Dresden beneath a crown. I have called it a matched group due to the differences in moulding and painting and some pieces have other factory marks beneath the overpainted Dresden marks.

3 of the saucers have faults.

Two saucer plates have faults.

6 of the 22cm plates have little faults.

3 cups have faults.

All the leaf dishes are in good order, with typical rubbing to the gilding.

Yellow chocolate cup with small chip to one foot.

Turquoise chocolate cup with small chip to one foot and cracked and chipped cover.

Both vases and covers are in good condition.

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
