A George Jones majolica garden seat, dated 1874, of cylindrical shape, relief decorated with birds and dragonflies amidst bulrushes above waterlilies against a turquoise ground, the brown glazed raffia effect top with hand hold aperture, impressed diamond registration lozenge to base interior side, height 45.5cm.

Estimate: £800 - £1,200

Condition Report

Typical overall fine crazing to the glaze.

There is a haircrack running from one end of the hand aperture down into the yellow band beneath the raffia effect top which displays typical wear commensurate with age and use. At the other end of the hand aperture is a much shorter and indistinct haircrack.

There are a few minor glaze frits to some of the high relief waterlilies, but nothing untoward. Overall fundamentally in good condition.
