### LOT 1866

An airtwist stem wine glass, mid 18th century, the ogee bowl engraved with a border of fruiting vine above a moulded base, raised on a plain stem with spiral threads outside a vertical thread, on a conical foot, height 14.8cm, together with six other 18th century wine glasses, comprising two airtwist stem examples, one with cut and faceted bowl, height 14.5cm, and four with faceted stems and simple engraved detail, tallest 18cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £80 - £120

### Condition Report

Engraved with fruiting vine - 2 tiny chips to edge of foot.

Airtwist with cut and faceted bowl - minor scratches but generally ok.

Other airtwist - badly chipped foot and bruise to bowl.

Tallest faceted stem - minute nick to rim of bowl which is badly scratched, foot badly chipped.

Second tallest faceted stem - foot reduced, otherwise ok.

Third tallest faceted stem - base interior of bowl quite scratched, otherwise ok.

Shortest faceted stem - some minor scratches to bowl, otherwise ok.
