LOT 1567

A Doccia porcelain part service, early 19th century, painted with birds in branches in landscape settings by water, in the style of Ammannati, comprising two pear-shaped pots and covers, height 14cm, a cylindrical preserve pot and cover with yellow flower finial, three teacups and three saucers, diameter 12.8cm, unmarked (minor faults).

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

In good condition overall with no significant damage and no repairs.

The two pots and covers are much more thickly potted than the other pieces in the lot with very little translucency and almost a faience type appearance to the bodies.

One saucer with small chip to rim at 7 o'clock and two tinier inconsequential nicks.

One pot and cover with minuscule nick to side exterior edge of spout.

Cylindrical pot and cover with haircrack to body, small firing crack to one notch of cover and chipping to yellow rose finial.

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
