A Frith Brookhouse studio pottery circular tureen and cover, painted with tenmoku trellis panels and patterned roundels against a blue ground, impressed seal marks to outer edge of foot, diameter 21.5cm, together with a small group of other studio pottery, including a Milland Pottery vase by Hawkins with vertical fluted decoration, height 34cm, and a teapot and cover and four teabowls by Karen Bunting.

Condition Report

Bunting teapot has small chip to underside edge of spout.
Grey glazed conical bowl has two vertical haircracks to rim.
Octagonal bowl has small nicks to facet edges, quite indistinct.
Rectangular vase has chip to one top corner.

Otherwise items in the lot are in good condition with no damage or repairs.

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
