LOT 1660

A Coalport porcelain Japan pattern part service, early 19th century, pattern No. 310, painted and gilt with a willow tree in a chinoiserie garden beneath a panelled border, comprising teapot, cover and stand, sucrier and cover, slop bowl, diameter 17.3cm, jug, saucer dish, diameter 19.8cm, nine cups and thirteen saucers, together with a New Hall Japan pattern teapot and cover, pattern No. 752 (faults and restoration).

Estimate: £120 - £180

Condition Report

Teapot - body badly cracked through sides and base, tiny chip to underside edge of cover.

Teapot stand - ok with light surface scratches.

Sucrier - condition ok, gilding on cover very worn.

Jug - gilding on handle worn, otherwise ok.

Slop bowl - some scratches to base interior, gilt rim rubbed.

Saucer dish - large chip to rim, light surface scratches.

Saucers - 7 ok but with varying wear, 6 with faults.

Cups - 6 ok but with varying degrees of wear to gilding, 2 ok but with very worn gilding, 1 with haircrack.

New Hall teapot - in good condition overall with light typical wear.

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
