A studio pottery vase in the style of Hans Coper, of compressed bulbous shape with short neck rim, covered in a matt black glaze, seal mark to base, height 9.5cm.

Estimate: £200 - £300

Condition Report

Fundamentally there are no condition issues although the surface of the vase is very blemished and not well finished. Some of the white body is showing through the black, particularly on the base. Some ♦fluffy♦ remnants are adhered to the base as though it previously had a felt circle stuck to it.

The ♦HC♦ mark is in relief with the shadow of a ♦ring♦ around it. We believe this to be a spurious Coper mark. The pot itself is thickly potted and quite weighty. The interior sides of the pot are white with a black interior base and neck rim.
