A large Zsolnay Pecs Alhambra vase, designed in 1884 by Tádé Sikorski, of Moorish style, the flared neck with a large pair of pierced wing type handles, raised on a spreading circular foot, impressed marks to base with shape No. 1027, height 47.5cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £400 - £600

Condition Report

Overall fundamentally in good condition.

Gilding on vase basically totally worn away.

One handle with minor and indistinct haircrack to outer pierced section, other handle with approx 2cm long unsprung chip to side edge.

Narrow small chip approx 1cm long to edge of foot and even smaller nick to edge of foot.

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
