A 'Vienna' porcelain goblet shaped vase, circa 1900, painted with a continuous gilt ground band of classical figures, indistinctly titled to base, against a gilt overlaid cobalt blue ground, underglaze blue beehive mark to base, height 21.3cm, together with pair of 'Vienna' style vases and covers with integral plinth bases, early 20th century, similarly painted and also with gilt overlaid cobalt blue ground bodies, blue printed marks to bases with indistinct titles, height 21cm (one knob with glued repair).

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

Goblet shaped vase - In good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration. The gilding and enamels are good with no wear. Probably lacking a cover.

First of pair - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration, very minor rubbing to gilding on high points.

Second of pair - knob of cover detached but available with the lot, chip to edge of cover and even smaller nick to flange of vase where cover sits which is quite inconsequential. Otherwise in good condition with again minor rubbing to gilding on high points.

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
