A late Victorian gold backed and silver set opal and diamond crescent shaped brooch, mounted with a row of thirteen graduated heart shaped opals within two rows of cushion shaped diamonds, unmarked, weight 11.5g, width 7.5cm.

Estimate: £1,200 - £1,800

Condition Report

717 - The brooch is in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs, just typical light surface scratches and wear. Would benefit from a clean.

The opals are a lovely colour with a nice play of pink and green hues. The smallest opal to the far right side has the most significant chip to the lower tip of the heart, otherwise light surface abrasions and some minor nicks but no significant damage or repairs. Diamonds are all present, bright and sparkly.

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
