A late 19th/early 20th century S. Hancock & Sons Morrisware inkwell and cover, designed by George Cartlidge, of rectangular shape, decorated with panels of berried foliage against a mottled green ground, model No. C53-2, green printed and painted marks to base, length 13cm (small chip to side edge).

Condition Report

Typical overall crazing to the glaze, with some staining visible to the underside of the well area when inverted - please see image 10 on our website.

No liner.

There is a 2cm long by 1cm deep flat chip to the side edge of one of the shorter sides - please see images 3 and 4 on our website using the zoom function.

The corners of the cover have some minuscule pinhead sized glaze nicks.
