A late Victorian silver three-piece bachelor's tea set of low-bellied form, embossed and chased with birds amongst flowers, on scroll feet, comprising teapot, two-handled sugar bowl and milk jug, Birmingham 1894 and 1897 by John Millward Banks, height of teapot 13cm, total weight 550.4g.

Condition Report

385. Teapot body generally ok but hinge lid is quite badly misshapen.

Sugar bowl - generally ok but minor misshaping to rim and slightly wobbly as feet are slightly bent.

Milk jug - slightly misshapen rim and feet. All with clear hallmarks, all with typical surface scratches and wear.

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
