Condition Report

417. George III mug - generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear commensurate with age. There is an engraved wreath cartouche to the front which has had erasure to the centre. Good clear hallmarks.

The later tankard is in generally good condition with typical light surface scratches and wear. Minor misshaping to rim and footrim. Good clear hallmarks.
