Condition Report

698. The piece is in generally very good condition commensurate with age.

The gold is in good order with the tongue of the clasp snapping in tightly and spring release working as it should.

Engraving the edge is still nice and crisp.

Blue enamel is good and vibrant and pearls are present and in good order.

Glazed panel in good condition and painting is ok with some loss/fading.
