A late 20th century French lacquered brass corniche cased carriage alarm clock by L'Epée, the eight day movement striking and repeating on a gong, the backplate with stamped maker's mark, the signed white enameled dial with black Roman hour numerals and subsidiary alarm dial, the case with swing handle and bevelled glass panels, height 17.4cm.

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1151. Cosmetically the clock is in generally good condition with some marks to the gilt lacquered base. Otherwise, just typical surface scratches and wear.

Glass in good condition.

Going train winds smoothly and it is currently running. The repeat mechanism also in good working order, but unfortunately the striking train does now wind and the strike does not work. Would require some attention to get back to full working order.

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
