A Timex Quartz stainless steel backed gentleman's wristwatch, the signed black dial with baton hour markers and day and date apertures, the case with rotating bezel, case width 3.8cm, on an expanding metal bracelet, together with Le Cheminant Master Mariner stainless steel gentleman's chronograph wristwatch with Landeron 149 caliber manual wind movement, the signed black dial with two subsidiary dials and centre stop seconds, the case back numbered '624103', case diameter 3.7cm, and a Tissot 9ct gold cushion cased gentleman's wristwatch, Birmingham 1940, case width 2.9cm, on a brown leather strap.

1125. Le Cheminant - typical surface scratches and wear. Dial in good order. Winds and adjusts smoothly and is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. The crystal is scratched but not cracked. Chronograph function starts to work but sweep seconds stops just before it reaches a full minute, so minute recording sub dial is not triggered so unable to tell if it functions fully. All buttons work and reset returns to vertical

Timex - not running at present but adjusts smoothly and day/date roll over as they should.

Tissot - typical light surface scratches and wear. Winds and adjust and is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.

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
