A mid to late 19th century French ormolu mantel clock, the eight day movement striking on a bell via an outside countwheel, the backplate stamped 'Moinet a Paris', the embossed gilt dial with white enamel hour plaques and blue Roman hour numerals, the rococo scroll moulded balloon shaped case cast with flowers and foliate scrolls, above a figure of Pan applied to front, on an integral scroll moulded base, height 40cm, with pendulum.
