A late 19th century French Egyptianesque slate and rouge marble mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, the dial with gilt Roman hour numerals, the architectural case with urn finial above a pair of bronze female figure columns, on a rectangular base with incised and gilt wings of Horus decoration, height 36.5cm, with pendulum.

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### Condition Report

1167. Generally good condition, no significant damage or repairs. A bit dusty and dirty. Minor nicks/chips to edges and corners of slate and rouge marble but nothing significant. Some wear to gilt decoration. The clock winds smoothly and is currently running, strike mechanism also in good working order, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch. The backplate has stamped Japy Freres mark.

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
