LOT 1222

An early 18th century longcase clock movement and dial with thirty hour movement, within a later walnut case, the 10-inch square dial with single hand and silvered chapter ring inscribed 'James Webb Bristol', the later walnut case with quarter veneered rectangular trunk door, on bracket feet, height 183.5cm, with pendulum, brass cased weight and winder (alterations and restoration).

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

1222. The case is generally in good condition, but does have typical condition issues such as chips and losses to veneers particularly around hood and base. Dial is worn and silvered chapter ring particularly worn. The clock is not currently running but everything appears to be present. Probably requires a service to return to full working order.

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
