A Smith Astral brass circular cased ship's radio room bulkhead timepiece, the signed painted dial with two red radio silence sectors and black Arabic hour numerals, the case with bevelled glass front door, case diameter 20.2cm. Note: the red sectors on the dial are for twice hourly radio silence intervals, introduced following the sinking of the Titanic in 1912, together with a brass cased Sestrel ship's wall barometer, the dial signed 'L.J. Harri Amsterdam', case diameter 20.5cm.

Condition Report

1204. Timepiece - typical surface scratches and wear to brass case. Hinged front door and glass in good order. Dial is worn with some paint loss. Seconds hand is a little bent. The movement winds smoothly and it is currently running, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability.
Barometer - typical surface scratches and wear to case. Minor chips to interior edge of glass. Dial with some discolouration, spotting and wear. Appears to be working, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability.

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
