A late 19th century French brass four glass mantel clock with eight day movement striking on a bell, with mercury compensated pendulum, the two piece enamelled dial with black Roman hour numerals and visible Brocot escapement, the case with stepped pediment above bevelled glass panels, on a plinth base and bracket feet, height 30.5cm.

Condition Report

1163. Generally good condition, case with wear to gilt lacquer, typical surface scratches and wear. All glass panels in good order and both hinged doors are good. Minor hairline crack to lower edge of enamel dial just below the 6 o'clock.

The two trains wind smoothly, it is currently running and strike mechanism in good working order, but please be aware we give no guarantees to working order or reliability of any clock or watch.
