An early Victorian Sheffield plate wine trolley, each circular coaster cast with foliate rims supported by four rotating six-spoke wheels, total length 48cm, a pair of George III Sheffield plate Corinthian column candlesticks, each with a detachable nozzle, on square beaded bases, height 28cm, a pair of Sheffield plate wine coasters and a pair of plated on copper single-light girandoles, each cast with scallop shell backs above a cluster of seashells, weight 20.5cm.

Condition Report

346. Girandoles - generally good, typical surface scratches and wear to plate. Each drip pan has a small hole behind the scone presumably to accommodate electric cable.

Pair of coasters - generally good condition, typical wear.

Pair of candlesticks - typical wear and scratches. One missing pine base panel, other with uneven base panel and loose filler inside base.

Wine trolley - generally ok with typical surface scratches and some wear. One silver boss is loose. Two wheels entirely missing their 'tyre' covering and one with half 'tyre' covering lost. The one wheel with covering is worn and misshapen.

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
