A pair of diamond and black enamel pendant earrings of tapered openwork geometric form, each collet set with the principal old cut cushion shaped diamond to the drop, otherwise set with smaller cushion shaped diamonds, with post and butterfly fittings, unmarked, total weight 6.5g, length 3.4cm, cased.

Condition Report

719. Generally in good condition with typical light surface scratches and wear to black enamel and mounts. Diamonds are bright and sparkly.

Each principal diamond has a diameter of approx 4.5mm and a depth of approx 2.7mm, so approx 0.30-0.35ct. The stones have not been professionally graded, but would suggest approx J/K colour and SI clarity.

The earrings are not marked or tested, but presumed to be 18ct white gold.
