### LOT 1082

A Chinese famille verte export porcelain jar and cover, Kangxi period, the domed cover and cylindrical body painted and gilt with opposing precious objects and flowers, on a circular foot, height 15.6cm (minor rim chips to cover).

Estimate: £400 - £600

### Condition Report

1082. The body of the jar is in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs. Typical light surface scratches and wear to enamels, otherwise decoration is fresh and vibrant. Blue glazed handles with light crazing.

The cover has three chips to the rim and typical surface scratches and wear to glaze, enamels and gilt, more pronounced on the knob.

The cover is a pretty good fit and the floral and precious objects decoration appears to be a good match with the decoration on the body of the jar. The border around the edge of the cover does differ from the other border decoration on the jar. It is possible the cover is matched, but if so it is a very good match - you probably need to decide for yourself.
