A Chinese underglaze blue and polychrome enamelled export porcelain bowl, Kangxi period, the exterior painted with birds and flowers, the interior with iron red flower sprays and roundel motifs, height 8.4cm, diameter 19cm (restored hairlines to rim).

Condition Report

1086. The bowl at first glance appears to be in good clean condition, but there are four very faint vertical hairline cracks to the rim visible under UV light, which have been bleached and restored (filled). Typical light surface scratches and wear to enamels.
