### LOT 1041

A garniture of three Japanese Imari porcelain vases and two covers, early 18th century, each baluster body painted and gilt with opposing flower panels reserved against landscape grounds, heights 30cm and 19.5cm.

### Condition Report

One vase with minor glazed over manufacturing chip to footrim and similar smaller blemish to top rim edge. Otherwise each vase in good condition with no cracks, chips or restoration. Each has some minor bubbled glaze blemishes to the body as a result of manufacture. Each has typical light surface scratches to the glaze and pronounced wear to the gilding commensurate with age and handling.

Covers - one with small chip to inner rim edge of flange, other with slightly bigger chip to outer rim edge of flange - neither visible when cover in position on vase. Otherwise both in good condition with no restoration but typical wear and surface scratches. Pronounced wear to the gilding.

Missing one cover.
