A Tibetan brown patinated and gilt bronze figure of a tantric mahasiddha, possibly Begtse, 17th century, the three-faced deity seated on the back of a roaring Buddhist lion, his six arms holding various attributes, his hair with red pigment detail, height 13.2cm. Estimate: £600 - £1,000

Condition Report

No significant damage or repairs.

Generally in good condition.

Typical surface scratches and wear to gilt and brown patina.

Red pigmentation to heads worn.

Rectangular copper patch to underside of lion - see images on website.

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
