A rare late Victorian silver novelty combination hip flask/stamp moistener and stamp box of tapering wedge shape, in the form of a tube of paint with screw cover, the front fitted with a hinged lidded stamp compartment, London 1899 by Sampson Mordan & Co, weight 47.9g, length 7.8cm.

Condition Report

398. Generally good condition but small dent to one side, to the left of the lid. Otherwise only very minor nicks and surface scratches to body. Hinge is good and clicks shut. Screw down cover closes tightly and cork to interior is present. Top of the cover has a couple of dents where the edge is pushed down a bit. Marks on cover slightly rubbed but just about readable.

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
