An Edwardian gold backed, silver set and diamond oval hinged bangle, the front claw set with a row of nine graduating old cut cushion shaped diamonds, otherwise set with smaller old cut cushion shaped and rose cut diamonds, on a snap clasp, fitted with a safety chain, unmarked, weight 26.9g, inside width 5.5cm, with a case.

Condition Report

765. The bangle is in good clean condition, with no significant damage or repairs. Hinges are good can clasp in good working order. The gold has been x-ray tested as 14ct gold with silver setting, but it is not hallmarked. Diamonds are bright and sparkly with no significant damage. Very approximate total carat weight 4-5ct. Approx I/J colour and I1/2 clarity as some diamond inclusions visible under x10 magnification. Case is a bit tatty.

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
