A late Victorian gold, silver set and diamond oval hinged bangle, the front formed as a row of eleven graduating clusters, each cluster mounted with an old cut cushion shaped diamond within a surround of rose cut diamonds, on a snap clasp, fitted with a safety chain, unmarked, weight 15.7g, inside width 5.5cm, with a case.

Estimate: £3,000 - £4,000

Condition Report

750. The bangle is in good clean condition with no significant damage or repairs. Hinge is good and clasp in good working order. The gold has been x-ray tested as 15ct gold with silver setting.

Diamonds are bright and sparkly. Very approx 4-5ct total, approx H/I colour and approx SI clarity.

Leather case in good order.
