A pair of Chinese turquoise glazed porcelain bottle vases, late Qing dynasty, each with globular body and slightly tapered slender cylindrical neck, height 25.5cm, together with a similar smaller turquoise glazed bottle vase, height 14.6cm, and a black glazed bottle vase, height 15cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £150 - £200

Condition Report

Pair of turquoise vases - generally good condition with typical light crazing to glaze. One with chip to footrim, the other with tiny chip to footrim and small chip to underside of base. Otherwise no significant damage or repairs.

Small turquoise vase - tiny glaze chip to footrim, otherwise in good condition.

Small black glazed vase - good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Only very minor light surface scratches.

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
