## **LOT 1159**

A pair of Chinese famille rose enamelled porcelain hexagonal hat stand vases, probably Tongzhi/Guangxu period, each side pierced with a quatrelobed aperture, painted and gilt with continuous figural scenes, height 27.8cm (one with hairline crack), each bearing wax Jianding export seal.

Estimate: £200 - £400

## **Condition Report**

1159. Both in generally good condition with typical light surface scratches and wear to enamels and glaze. Wear to gilt on rims. Decoration is bright and vibrant.

Vase 1 - hairline crack running diagonally from the bottom of one aperture to the top of a lower aperture (approx 10cm long).

Vase 2 - small chip and small hairline crack (approx 1.8cm long) to top of lower aperture, and a small hairline firing crack to rim (approx 1cm long).
