A Chinese famille rose enamelled porcelain cylindrical hat stand vase, mark of Yongzheng but probably Guangxu period, pierced with six quatrelobed apertures, densely painted and gilt with precious objects, butterflies, fruit and Buddhistic emblems, iron red painted seal mark to base, height 28.2cm.
