A Japanese Satsuma earthenware circular bowl by Kinkozan, Meiji period, the interior finely painted and gilt with figures walking around blossom trees, with pavilion and waterfall beyond, beneath a rim of simulated brocade panels, the exterior with panels of figures, landscapes and simulated brocade, impressed signature seal to base, height 8cm, diameter 18.7cm.

Condition Report

1179. Generally good condition, typical crazing to glaze and some areas of discolouration, most noticeable to base. Typical light surface scratches and wear to gilt and enamels, more pronounced wear to gilt on rim. Otherwise gilt and enamels are good and vibrant.
