A pair of Chinese Canton famille rose porcelain vases, mid to late 19th century, each typically painted and gilt with panels of figures, butterflies, birds and flowers, with applied gilt chilong to shoulders and Buddhist lion handles, height 20.5cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1019. One vase in generally good condition with no significant damage or repairs, typical surface scratches and wear to gilt and enamels.

The other vase has a small chip to the underside of the rim. There is also a 'U' shaped hairline crack to the body which is not obviously noticeable until put under a UV light (approx 8cm across the body).
