A 19th century and later swordstick with straight double-edged fullered blade, blade length 81.5cm, finely etched with foliate decoration and military trophies and detailed 'Labruna Napoli 1845', and two-part carved horn lion-head handle, with wood scabbard (blade and handle probably associated).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

3514. Some small losses, chips around point where the head meets the handle grip, possible evidence of old re-fitting, small split and small losses to horn where blade meets the handle.

Blade generally in good condition, some discolouration in places.

Scabbard generally in good condition, looks to have been varnished at some point, later ferrule applied.

As stated in catalogue description, the blade has probably been associated to the stick, but has been done a long time ago.
