British School (late 18th century) - Half-length portrait of a young lady; Half-length portrait of a boy, identified as 'Jane Newcomb, daughter of Ch. Newcomb of Coventry & Stoke' and 'John Newcomb...', a pair, oil on panel, oval, each 19cm x 15.5cm, both within a pressed metal frames, together with a watercolour portrait of a child holding a whip, attributed to George Smith (3).

Estimate: £150 - £250

Condition Report

All under glass, retouching visible to the male portrait under u.v. light, both with some craquelure, would benefit from cleaning; Watercolour faded. Foxed, discoloured, needs cleaning.

Oval frames are pressed metal on a wooden base. Discoloured but intact.

Overall size, including frame, ovals each 24.5cm x 21cm, watercolour 23.5cm x 19cm.
