### LOT 1655

Two small porcelain plates, Eastern European, possibly Russian (Baranowka), circa 1900, printed and painted with head and shoulder busts of elegant ladies in period dress, impressed mark to one, 13.3cm and 14cm diameter.

### Condition Report

Girl with pink flowers in hair - the reverse of this plate has a glued plate holder disc which has not been removed. There is an indistinct approx 1cm long haircrack to the rim visible to the underside but not the surface due to the dark ground. Tiny flaked glaze spot to dark ground at 9 o'clock between the rim edge and her nose. Some stray glue remnants to edge as though there has previously been a frame of some sort.

Girl with gold and white headscarf - there is an approx 1cm long haircrack to the rim at 10 o'clock, only noticeable to underside due to dark ground, otherwise in good condition.
