### LOT 1469

A Flight, Barr & Barr Worcester basket shaped card tray, early 19th century, painted with butterflies and fruit against a green ground within a rim of moulded gilt edged overlapping leaves, with overhead handle, raised on four gilt paw feet, iron red printed mark to base, diameter 21.5cm (handle restored), together with a Flight & Barr Worcester orange ground jardiniere painted with a floral panel, height 15.8cm (extensively restored), and a Barr Worcester two-handled cup and cover painted with a floral panel against a black pseudo marbled ground, height 11.3cm (faults and restoration). Provenance: The Flight Collection.

### Condition Report

Basket - handle has been broken away at both terminal ends and professionally restored with signs of previous rivet repairs to the underside prior to the current restoration. A few minor and light scratches to the painted decoration.

Jardiniere - overall broken into a number of large pieces and professionally but visibly restored.

Cup and cover - large section of main body broken away (not through the flower panel) and visibly glued back into position, cover missing finial and with filled chip to upper outer edge, overall rubbing to gilding on high points and edges, light scratches overall.
