### LOT 1705

Thirteen mostly Coalport cabinet cups and saucers, 19th and 20th century, including a trio painted with flowering plants within gilt frames against a grey ground, a similar cobalt blue ground Adelaide shape trio, two other teacups and saucers of Adelaide shape, a London shape cup and saucer painted with panels of birds and flowers against a cobalt blue ground, a cream ground Etruscan shaped cup and saucer with floral panels and a gilt ground example with high ring handle painted with flowers, together with two Anstice Horton & Rose blue printed teapots and covers and a similar jug (faults).

### Condition Report

Yellow ground floral painted cup and saucer - cup is crazed, otherwise ok.

Grey ground floral painted teacup and saucer - saucer crazed otherwise ok.

Gilt ground floral teacup and saucer - both pieces crazed otherwise ok.

Pale blue teacup and saucer - saucer crazed, otherwise ok.

Cobalt blue ground floral cup with ring handle - small crack to handle, otherwise ok.

Grey ground trio with flowering plants - minor regilding to rim of coffee cup, otherwise ok.

Cup and saucer with pink rosebuds within blue and gilt scrolls - handle of teacup restored, both pieces crazed.

Blue and gilt weed cup and saucer - each piece crazed and worn.

Jug - crazed with light wear to gilding.

Teapots - one with riveted repair to end of spout, other with crazed cover, small starcrack to base and minuscule nick to tip of spout.
