### LOT 1535

An Italian Capodimonte Triade bisque porcelain figure of an artist, by Benacchio, raised on a gilt metal base, height 36cm, together with five Capodimonte figures by Merli, including a standing female figure titled Gipsy, height 30cm, and another similar group of a seated couple, various painted, impressed and incised factory marks (minor faults and repairs).

Estimate: £70 - £100

### Condition Report

Seated couple, she holding rose in her hand - in good condition overall, a couple of very tiny and insignificant chips to tips of relief leaves mainly to plant but also to one leaf of rose held in her hand, otherwise no cracks, chips or restoration.

Lady playing cello - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration, bow for cello is detached but available with the lot.

Gypsy - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Lady seated on chair holding baby - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Standing couple - in good condition overall with no cracks, chips or restoration.

Female artist - easel badly damaged and missing most of it, the picture she is painting is held in place with blu-tac.

Male artist - missing paintbrush from hand, blue vase beside him missing one handle and something missing from surface beside this blue vase, inconsequential losses and chips to tips of green foliage and some petals.
