A Barr, Flight & Barr Worcester vase and replacement wood cover, early 19th century, the ogee body painted with three panels of peasant figures within gilt weed framing, raised on tripod column form legs surmounted with gilt masks, on a trefoil base, all with pseudo grey marble decoration, the later carved wood cover with gilt flame finial, puce painted mark to base, overall height 22cm (minor restoration). Provenance: The Flight Collection.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

The vase itself is overall in good condition with only a minor spot of restoration running horizontally across the top of one figure panel for approx 3cm - it is supposed to be covering a firing crack which is just about visible to the interior, but the colour matching is poor and I'm sure could be improved greatly. Otherwise the vase is in good condition with only a minor spot of discoloured pitting to the foot of one column and light typical rubbing to the gilding.

The cover is a painted wood replacement which is well matched and carved but its painted surface is peeling in places and flaked in others - please see image 5 on our website using the zoom function.
